## Missing children - (116000 The national hotline number for missing children

Did you know that the line 116000 is the support line for children, parents and guardians in institutions in the case of:

- a child is missing
- child runaways from home or institutions
- parental/international child abduction
- missing unaccompanied migrant children or child trafficking victims

The Center's trained professionals provide support and useful information on the 116 000 hotline, available 24/7 and free of charge so that the child is found and returned to safety as quickly as possible.

We organize a lot of educational activities to prevent the phenomena of missing children and we are also raising awareness among experts and citizens about this issue.

# Treatment work with children

The Centre for missing and exploited children has established Prevention and treatment centres for working with children in 6 different cities across Croatia.

We offer a half-day care service which provides daily help and support for over 100 children, lacking support in their living environment.

The half-day care treatment includes:

- psychosocial support (individual and group counselling for children and their families)
- work habits and independence development and raising health care awareness
- social and communication skills workshops
- help and support in education
- · cooperation with parents, educational experts and relevant institutions
- organization of non-curricular activities for quality free time spending (creative, sports, informatic workshops and other fun activities)
